

## **ADDENDUM A : PlanetSustain Eco Club Student activities**

PlanetSustain Eco Clubs' associated students should demonstrate significant efforts in reducing their household consumption related carbon footprint, as well as promoting environmental awareness through community activities. PlanetSustain Eco Clubs must provide evidence of their initiatives by tracking data using the PlanetSustain Mobile App to be considered for selection and shortlisting, subject to verification of data and activities.

The PlanetSustain Eco club should be active and must operate for any six months to be eligible for prizes and awards from January 1, 2025, to September 30, 2025. The PlanetSustain Eco Club activities must start at the beginning of a month, such as January 1st, February 1st, March 1st, or April 1st, and should conclude its activities within six months, not later than September 30, 2025

### **a. Energy Consumption Reduction**

Student members will track and aim to reduce household electricity consumption by 5% during any 6-month period from January to September 2025, based on baseline data calculated from the average electricity consumption over the previous 3 months. The goal is to achieve a minimum reduction of 5% month-on-month, compared to the baseline average from the previous 3 months, for each month during the 6-month period. Progress will be entered and verified against the household electricity data submitted by 30th September 2025.

All students from shortlisted PlanetSustain Eco Clubs will be required to submit electricity bills for a nine-month period (3 months prior to the start of the activity + 6 months) for verification by InvoSystems. The PlanetSustain Eco Club will be disqualified if the data entered in the app does not match the submitted electricity bills. Only electricity bills from the student's home will be accepted. InvoSystems may carry out additional checks if the student has submitted the actual electricity bill for their residence

While registering for the PlanetSustain Mobile App, the City/State and Postal Code should match the information on the electricity bill.

### **b. Donate Books and Clothes**

Student members should exercise social responsibility by donating their old study books, which may be useful to other students, and clothes in good condition to needy students and charities, as recognized by the respective educational institutions.

Students should organize a donation day during the last three months of the 6-month activity period to collect their books and clothes ( clean ) in good condition, placing them in a common room as allowed and approved by the educational institutions.

Before donating, students should take a photo and weigh the items they intend to donate, then enter the data in the PlanetSustain Mobile App under 'DONATE'.

The above activities should be coordinated in consultation with the mentor teacher and the principal

- c. Community Outreach initiatives
- **Conducting workshops on sustainable living** practices, such as energy conservation with responsible consumption and waste reduction.
  - Organizing seminars on the importance of upcycling electronic appliances and their environmental benefits, alongside hosting workshops on basic electronics repair to teach community members how to fix and extend the life of their devices
- d. Fostering Climate Action Awareness
- **Organizing awareness campaigns** to educate the community about the impacts of climate change and the importance of taking action.
  - **Hosting informational seminars** on climate science, renewable energy, and sustainable living practices.
  - **Creating social media content** (videos, infographics, posts) to spread knowledge about climate action and environmental issues.
  - **Launching educational initiatives in schools** to teach students about climate change, its effects, and how to make a difference

e. Points for each activity listed above: 100 points (100%).

f. Key Notes

- 1) The points award for activity 1 and 2 will be computed by the PlanetSustain Server.
- 2) Community Outreach initiatives and Fostering Climate Action Awareness will be conducted as club activities with the participation of all 25 student members. The shortlisted Eco Clubs must submit proof of such activities to [ancilla@invoystems.com](mailto:ancilla@invoystems.com) for review by the Jury members. The Jury's decision will be final for the awarding of 20 points
- 3) In case none of the Eco Clubs win the Championship 2025, the championship prize of a trip to Singapore (3 pax) will be deferred and added to the prizes for the 2026 Championship. However, other accolades and cash rewards, as listed in Addendum F, will be awarded to the top-ranking clubs and individual students
